Firstly, we would like to thank all the parents and carers for their much appreciated help over this busy year. Without this help so many of the things that have occurred throughout the year would not have been possible. Your help and support with the following is most treasured: incursions and excursions, washing roster, kinder duty and helping out when we have had no one able to stay, making smocks, bringing in dress ups for the children to wear, remembering dress up days and coming up with extremely creative costumes, attending special days held at kinder, bringing in useful resources that we can use in our program, helping out with special days such as the visit to the Belgrave South Fire station and having the ambulance visit and the list goes on and on....

School transition has been an integral part of this term. The children have really enjoyed spending time either at Selby school, Belgrave South and Narre Warren North Primary and from all reports each transition went very smoothly. We had a visit from Wendy from the museum. She told us a story about dinosaurs and why they are extinct today. Wendy showed us some real dinosaur bones. With help from some kinder friends we uncovered the foot and 2 leg bones of a Tsintasarous.

Wendy and Jo helped put the bones together and we got to see just how big this dinosaur really was. The children also got to see its head and how it had a horn on it. Wendy also brought in fossils which the children got to touch and hold.
